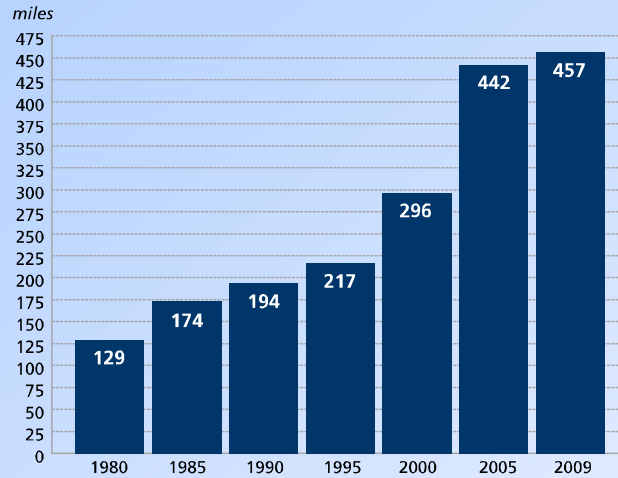

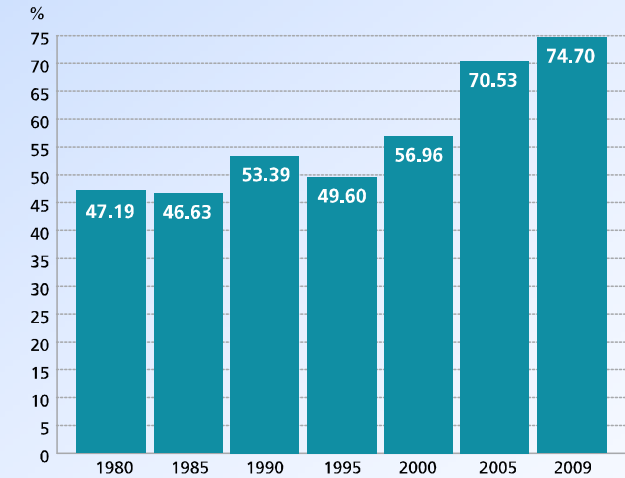

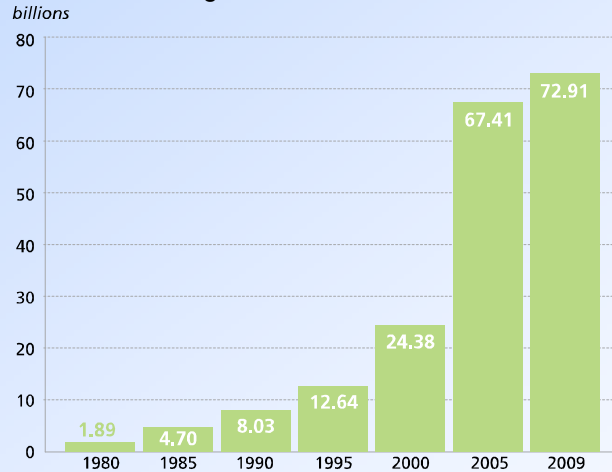
Average Passenger Trip Length



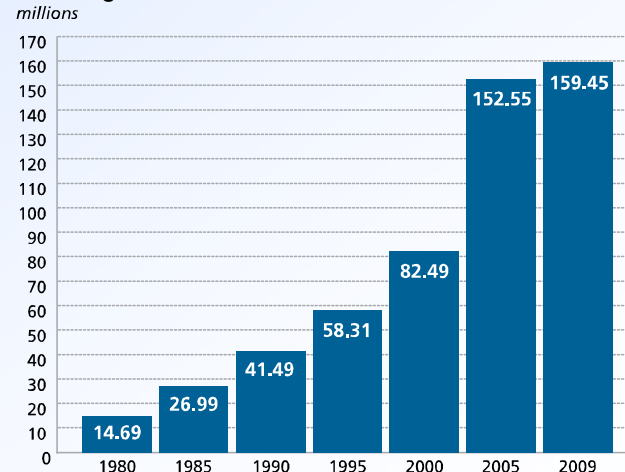
Average Load Factor



Revenue Passenger Miles



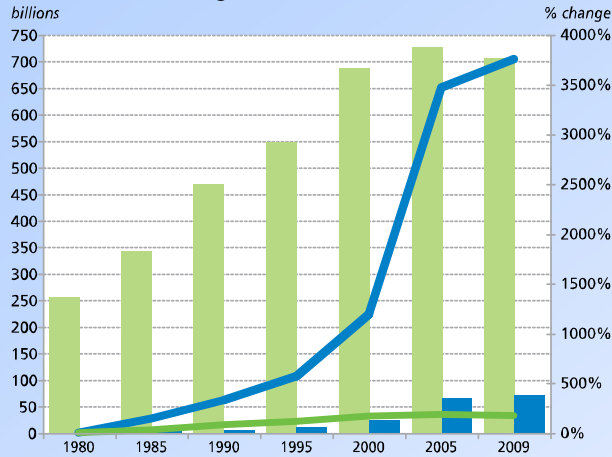

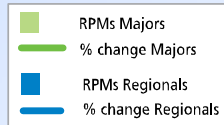
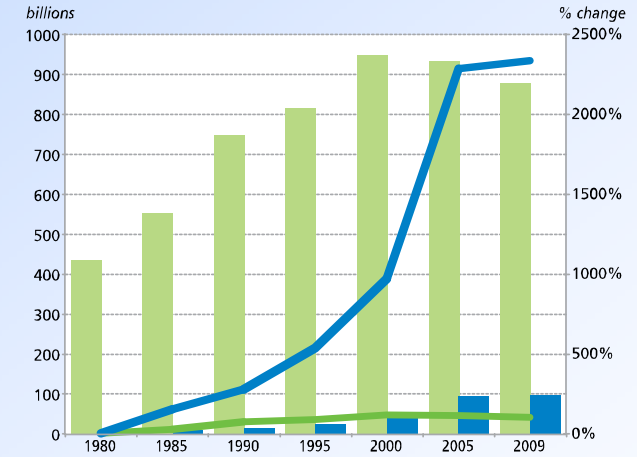


Majors/Regionals Share of Airline Service 1980-2009

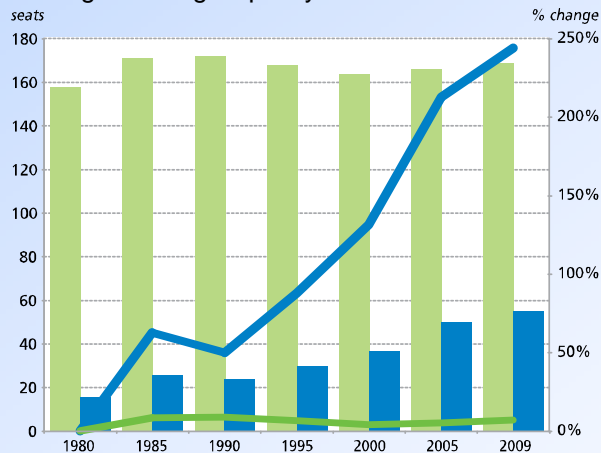
Revenue Passenger Miles



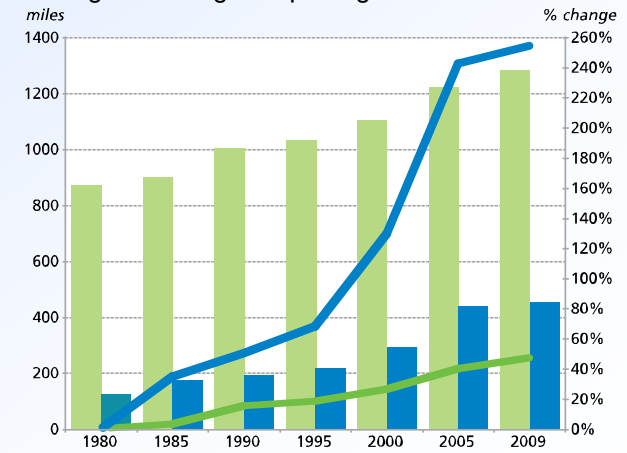
Available Seat Miles



Average Seating Capacity



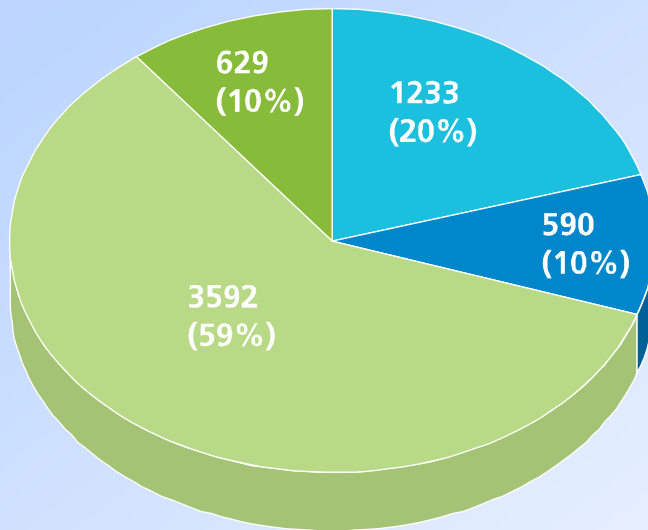

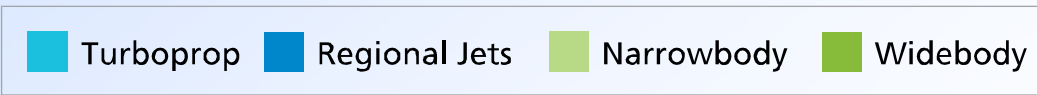
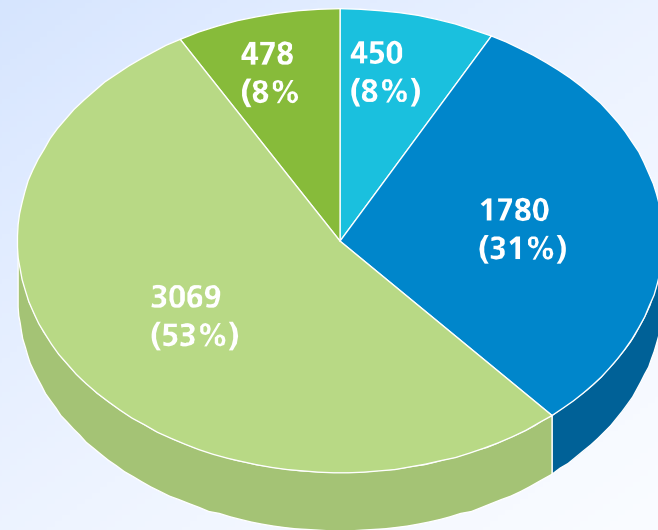


Scheduled Passenger Aircraft by Type

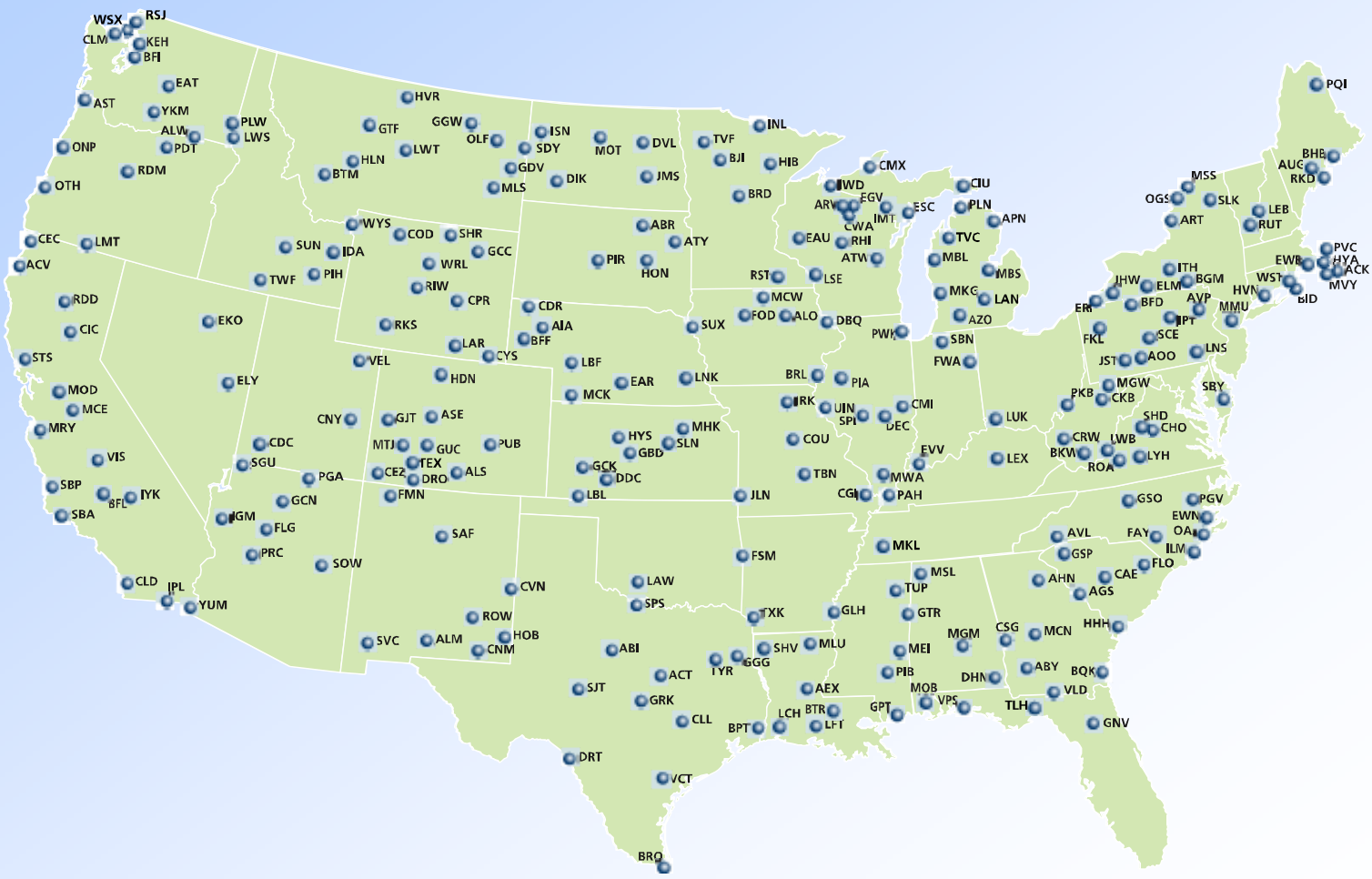

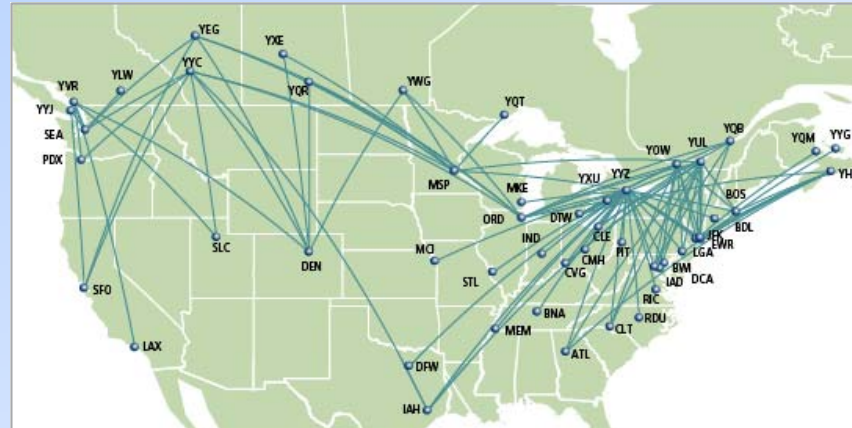
US Airports Served Exclusively by Regional Airlines
