

# **Regional Airline Association – Safety Information and Waiver for In-Person Attendees**

The safety of those attending RAA's 2021 Leaders Conference is a priority. In response to COVID-19, attendees must agree to the following requirements prior to registering for the 2021 Leaders Conference.

## **Duty of Care**

### **Before Leaving Home**

- Attendees must follow relevant guidance provided by the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and/or their local health authority.
- Attendees must adhere to government-issued travel guidance and all applicable restrictions issued by the authorities in the region to which you are traveling and from which you are traveling.
- Attendees must STAY HOME if they feel ill, actively experience COVID-19 symptoms, or have been exposed to someone who has tested positive or presumed to be positive within 14 days prior to the conference.

### **On-Site During the Conference**

- All attendees and their guests will abide by state and local ordinances and the National Housing Center's policies related to COVID-19 prevention. The National Housing Center will follow the CDC and local authority guidance at the time of the conference.

- If an attendee begins to actively experience COVID-19 symptoms during the conference they should self-quarantine immediately and notify RAA staff.

### **Personal Accountability Commitment**

By registering for and attending RAA's 2021 Leaders Conference, you agree to abide by, and engage in, the outlined health-and-safety conduct while attending the event. This includes, but is not limited to:

- Adhering to all Duty of Care Attendee Requirements outlined above.
- Following state and local ordinances and venue policies related to COVID-19 prevention and preventative measures.
- Engaging in appropriate physical distancing and hygiene practices.
- Making appropriate use of safety resources provided onsite.

- Not attending the conference if you are ill, actively experiencing COVID-19 symptoms or have recently been in close contact with someone who has tested positive or been diagnosed with COVID-19 within 14 days of the conference dates.
- Notifying RAA staff if you test positive for COVID-10 up to 14 days after returning home, or in accordance with current contact tracing advice from federal and state health authorities.

## **Waiver**

The Regional Airline Association will announce and enforce safety protocols for the conference. You agree to comply with the safety protocols put in place for the conference. You also understand that RAA may introduce and enforce new safety protocols for the event that are not listed above in this document and by clicking yes, you indicate that you will stay abreast of and compliant of all RAA event protocols. You also acknowledge that traveling to and participating in group events involves risk of contracting communicable diseases, including but not limited to COVID-19. You agree to waive and hold harmless RAA and its representatives from and against any liability arising from contraction of communicable diseases, including but not limited to COVID-19.
