Don Dillman is Senior Vice President of FedEx Express Flight Operations.

Appointed Sept. 1, 2018, Mr. Dillman oversees the company's global Flight Operations organization, which includes a crew force of more than 5,600 pilots operating a fleet of more than 680 aircraft, serving more than 650 airports worldwide.

He reports to Scot Struminger, Executive Vice President, FedEx Express Air Operations.

In his previous role as Vice President of Air Operations Training, Mr. Dillman was responsible for the planning, development, direction and control of the flight training elements of FedEx Express Air Operations in order to meet the highest levels of aviation safety, effectiveness, and efficiency.

Additionally, Mr. Dillman was responsible for the development, planning, implementation, and evaluation compliance to standards pertaining to the safe, legal, reliable, and efficient operation of all FedEx Express aircraft fleets to ensure compliance with federal aviation regulations.

Before joining FedEx Express in 2014, Mr. Dillman was the Managing Director of Flight Operations for Airlines for America; Vice President of Network Operations Control at United Airlines, and Managing Director of Flight Operations and Systems Operations Control at American Airlines.

Married with three children, Mr. Dillman resides near Memphis, Tenn. He holds a Bachelor of Science in Aeronautical Engineering degree from the United States Air Force Academy and an MBA from Capella University.

He currently serves as the co-chair of the FAA Air Carrier Training Aviation Rulemaking Committee (ACT ARC).
