Dion Flannery is President of PSA Airlines, a post he has held since 2014. He is responsible for oversight of the American Airlines wholly owned regional carrier's operations. Since joining the company, Dion has led the rapid transformation of a small regional airline with 49 aircraft to one that has over 130 aircraft today. With a strong commitment to the PSA team, intensifying training and development, as well as elevating operational performance, Dion has positioned the airline for continued growth and success. As the second largest American Eagle carrier, PSA currently operates a fleet of Bombardier CRJ-700 and -900NG regional jets, has over 4,300 team members, and serves over 90 domestic and international destinations via 750 daily departures.

In his previous position as president of US Airways Express, Dion was responsible for the wholly owned regional airlines, PSA and Piedmont Airlines, as well as the seven regional affiliates that operated as US Airways Express. He managed more than \$3 billion in annual contract and operating costs, a combined fleet of 295 aircraft and more than 1,900 daily departures. He has held positions as vice president – Financial Analysis for US Airways, vice president – Scheduling and Route Planning for America West Airlines and various positions within Continental Airlines, including senior director – Long-range Schedule Planning.

Dion earned a bachelor's degree in advertising from the University of Texas at Austin and a Master of Business Administration degree with a concentration in finance from the University of Houston.
