



John Sullivan is Executive Chairman and majority shareholder of CommutAir, a Part 121 scheduled passenger airline operating in the U.S., Mexico and Canada. He is also Chairman and CEO of Champlain Enterprises, Inc., a New York Corporation and airline holding company.

Prior to founding CommutAir in 1989 with his partners, Tony von Elbe and Jim Drollette, Sullivan was a Corporate Vice President of Brockway, Inc., a NYSE company based in Pennsylvania. He became President of Brockway's regional airline division, which he formed. In the latter capacity, he was directly responsible for the division's three regional airline subsidiaries: Air North in Burlington, Vermont, Clinton Aero in Plattsburgh, New York and Crown Airways in Dubois, Pennsylvania.

Earlier in his career, he was President of Air North and its FBO Northern Airways, President and founder of Northeast Airline Services and Vice President - Finance of Clinton Aero Corporation.
