



## **MICHAEL W. REYNOLDS, SENIOR PUBLIC ADVISOR, BAKER DONELSON**

Michael Reynolds is a Senior Public Policy Advisor with the firm of Baker Donelson. Previously, Mr. Reynolds served as Deputy Policy Director on the staff of the Senate Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation and was the team lead for aviation for Ranking Member Roger Wicker (R-MS). Prior to joining the Commerce Committee in 2015 (under then-Chairman Thune) as aviation counsel, Mr. Reynolds was a stay-at-home parent living with his family in the Netherlands.

In 2009, Mr. Reynolds worked for Booz Allen Hamilton as an Executive Advisor to the firm's transportation team.

Before Booz Allen, Mr. Reynolds was the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Transportation for Aviation and International Affairs from October 2002 until January 2009. While at DOT, he served as the Acting Assistant Secretary for more than two years.

Before joining the DOT, Mr. Reynolds spent seven and a half years serving as aviation counsel on the Senate Commerce Committee.

In 1997, Mr. Reynolds took a six-month leave of absence from his Senate position to serve as General Counsel to the National Civil Aviation Review Commission (also known as the Mineta Commission).

Prior to joining the public sector, Mr. Reynolds worked as a litigator in a prominent law firm in the San Francisco Bay Area.

Mr. Reynolds has an undergraduate degree in Political Science from Stanford University and a law degree from the College of William and Mary.
